All About Me Wearable Signs

All About Me signs are designed to provide children with clear, visual reminders of the other person's interests in conversation. They are useful in conversation practice in small group and classroom learning situations.

The four spaces provided on the sign are for the child to draw pictures of the things they like to talk about. The boxes are for them to write down the words. Depending on the age and writing ability of your clients, you may decide to use only pictures or only words.

The space at the top is for participants to write their names.

Use string to tie them around the necks of pairs or groups of children. The signs provide a visual reference for what the other person likes to talk about.


