Kids like real money.



So, I created play money that looks real.

To use as reward tokens in therapy and teaching.

You give it out in all kinds of teaching and therapy activities.

To encourage effort, persistence and learning.



For example, you can hand out these "good attention" tokens to indicate you notice gaze directed towards you and evidence of listening.



Use in combination with other learning materials.

Suggestion:

Provide a cup to hold the token money so kids are not distracted by playing with it.



Suggestion:

Use "Good Sport" money during games to promote pro-social game behavior.



There is a blank one for customizing your own token money.

Write down the thing you are working on. Hand it out when the child shows insights or progress.

Should you have kids exchange the money for prizes? In my opinion, this is generally not necessary. Tell kids this is play money, to make learning like a game.

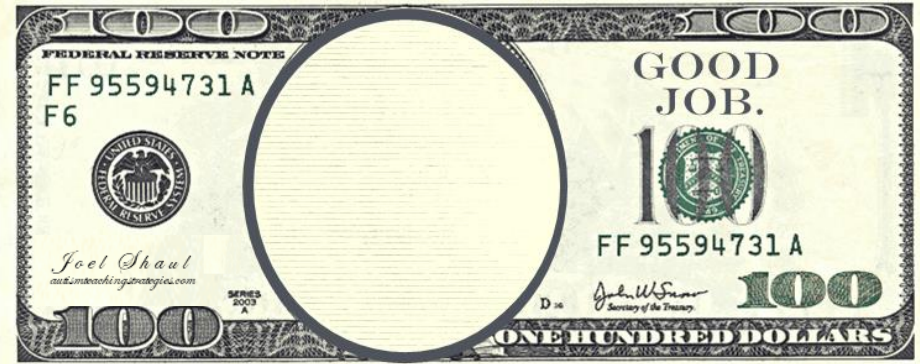
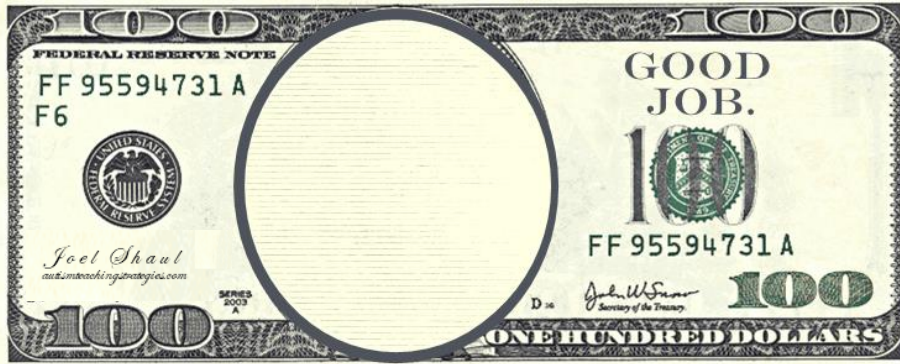
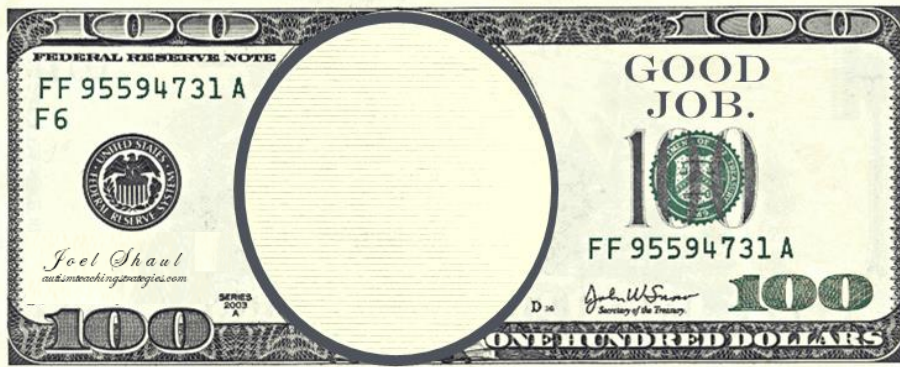
